Dear First Brethren Church Colony,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. I want to thank you for your faithfulness to our Lord and the people of FBCSB. You are an invaluable part of this colony and the work that God has called us to do for His honor and glory.



I cannot believe that it has been just over 10 years ago that we first met this church family. Our family thanks you for your friendship, prayers, support and all that you have given to us. We have seen many changes in these 10 years, especially making our way through covid and we have had many loved ones leave us for God's eternal home.

We praise the Lord for providing for us in every way at FCBSB. We have paid off the building and are now working on repaving the parking lot. We have added streaming to our services for those that cannot attend. Our food pantry ministry has grown exponentially, we have a new Community Care Ministry, and we have more Bible Study opportunities, including leadership development.

With that all being said, the FBC Board of Directors has approved for my family to take a sabbatical this July. I know that this was presented at the Congregational meeting in December, but I want to write to you each month so that you are aware of all that is being planned and will take place.

First, I want to give a simple explanation of what is a sabbatical (Lev 25). A true Sabbatical is a season of Sabbath for prolonged rest. It's like stringing together a number of Sabbath days. It's an extended time in which you do no work. You do no pastoring, no leading, no ministering, no visioning the future of the church, no sermon planning. You don't try to accomplish anything big. You just "do nothing"! (soulsheppherding.org)

Second, why is this needed? Bill Gaultiere writes, "I can state without wavering that the single greatest need of the church today is the restoration of ministers." His research has revealed these interesting statistics about those in fulltime ministry:

- 90% feel fatigued and worn out every week
- 91% have experienced some form of burn out
- 80% feel unappreciated and left out & unappreciated by church members
- 80% feel pressured to serve in ways that do not fit their gifts
- 72% only study the Bible when preparing their sermons for others
- 70% do not have a close friend
- 50% do not regularly meet with an accountability partner or group
- 44% do not regularly take a day off
- 85% have never taken a Sabbatical!

I thank the Lord that He has brought my family through many trials and tests over the years, but I must admit that I do long for a time to not have pastoral responsibilities and spend uninterrupted times with the Lord in prayer and meditation. This is what I view this sabbatical to be for me personally. We will enjoy some time away and visit other churches (rest assured that we are not leaving FBCSB), but we will enjoy being with other Brethren brothers and sisters.

As we journey through this process together, I want you to be able to ask whatever questions you have for me. I will be writing you a letter each month so you are aware of all that is taking place. We will keep you up to date as plans are made.

Right now, We will be making these following changes for the month of July.

- ~ Services will be at our normal 9:30am timeslot for Sundays 7/7, 7/14, 7/21, 7/28, 8/4
- ~ Second hour classes will not meet, but fellowship and service opportunities will be held during the second hour timeslot more information to come!
- ~ The Office will be open but on a limited basis (more details later)

I am currently working on special speakers and musicians for the services and people to fill in for daily responsibilities. I have assembled a "Renewal Team" that will keep me on task during the sabbatical. Also, I will be asking for people to sign up as a prayer team for us during that time.

I want to reiterate that the sabbatical is not because we are in need of time away, or that something is wrong, or that we are going somewhere else, but it is a needed time away from full-time ministry responsibilities so that we can focus on our personal mental, emotional and spiritual lives.

We love our FBCSB colony. I am looking forward to serving you now and for many years to come. Thank you for being a loving congregation and for your passion for our God. Please pray for us as we prepare for this adventure. I am praying for God to use this time for our growth both personal and as a congregation to lead us on to a more effective ministry for the Lord. 
