From the Pastor's Office . . .

Well, it's time again to write another newsletter article. I sometimes wonder what good is there in writing this article and does anyone really get anything out of it. As I ponder the purpose of the newsletter, I've concluded that it is a written form of communication at FBCSB for information (news), scheduling (events), and encouragement (articles).



As I look back to the first church newsletter that I wrote back in 1985, there has been a considerable change since then (other than I hope I write better now J). It was typed on an IBM typewriter and copied on a Xerox 50 series copier. No computer used, no email delivery and definitely no color print. Everything was black and white until we got a color printer in the late 2000's.

We have changed even since I have been here in South Bend for 9 years. We not only communicate through the printed newsletter and bulletin, but now with a website, Facebook, and streaming our services. Our FBC finances remain strong. We have been richly blessed with givers who Our FBC finances remain strong. We have been richly blessed with givers who faithfully provide to cover our financial obligations. Year-to-date through June we have received income of \$83,880 and incurred \$84,877 in expenses, which means have received income of \$83,880 and incurred \$84,877 in expenses, which means our expenses have surpassed our income by about \$1,000. Overall, this is not concerning as the timing of some of our expenses is primarily causing this difference. I'm happy

to report that we have not had any extraordinary expenses for the first half of the year. The trustees continue to make minor improvements to our property and equipment but there have been no major repairs or improvements. I want to thank our outstanding treasurer (Mary Wisniewski) and vice-treasurer (Rich Hollister) for their faithfulness in keeping our financial records in order and for their commitment to making sure our bills are paid timely. As you know, we have some major repairs on the horizon (parking lot and roof) so if you feel lead to give towards these projects, please mark your donation as "capital improvements". Financial statements are available upon request – please contact me or Janna to receive a copy.
